

# Visit of Erasmus lecturer from Poland

The Institute of Business and Technology in Ceske Budejovice was visited by the Polish lecturer Mr Bogodar Zielnica from Wroclaw School of Banking in May, 16th–20th under the terms of Erasmus programme for teachers. The Department of Foreign Languages looked after him during his staying, i.e. having assisted him while he was giving a talk and lessons to the Institute students, having prepared for him meeting the all members of the Department when various matters regarding the tertiary education were discussed, having showed him round in the city.

*Wroclaw School of Banking is a higher education institution founded by TEB Education Corporation in 1998. In accordance with the decision of the Minister of National Education on **27 August 1998 WSB** became a registered college of vocational education. The School functions in a holding group organized by its founder (TEB Education Corporation) that is one of the largest non-state teaching institutions in Poland.*

*Wroclaw School of Banking under the decision of Ministry of Science and Higher Education (no. DSW-3-4003-108/06) of 21st September 2006 opened a **faculty in Opole**. The School received entitlements to conduct BA and Post-graduate studies in the Faculty in Opole. (Wroclaw School of Banking 2007).*

His stay was very enriching for the Department of Foreign Languages. First, the exchange of information on the tertiary education, a discussion on different language-education approaches, comparison of Polish and Czech education system. Next, establishment of relations with an institution focusing on the similar study programmes in Poland for academic staff as well as the Institute students.
