The 14th International Scientific Conference “Human Resources Management: Current Trends, Challenges and Inspirations”

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The 14th international scientific conference “Human Resources Management: Current Trends, Challenges and Inspirations” took place on 20th – 21st April 2017 in Trenčianske Teplice, Slovak Republic, in the beautiful surroundings of Hotel Krym. The main objective of the conference was the mutual exchange of new scientific findings and practical experience in the field of Human Resources Management and other relevant topics. The conference, which was organised by Alexander Dubček of the University of Trenčín, Faculty of Social and Economic Relations, was divided into two themed parts. The first one was led by Prof. Rolf Karbach and by associate professor Tatiana Masárová, the second one by Prof. Sergej Vojtovič and Prof. Jaroslav Holomek. The members of the Scientific Board were drawn from the Slovak Republic, Czech Republic, Germany, Spain, Lithuania and Hungary. All the contributions were very good. Otakar Němec, CSc. (University of Economics, Prague, Czech Republic).

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
